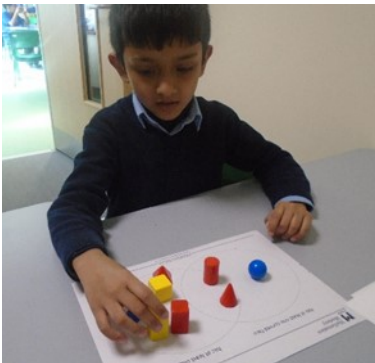
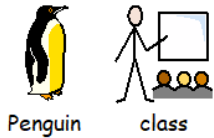

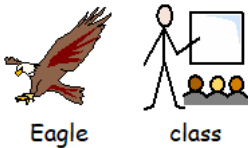
Penguin Class have had lots fun exploring plants in science. We have especially enjoyed planting our own seeds to investigate what plants need the most to



In maths penguin class have been focusing on shape and pattern. We have been learning about 2D and 3D shapes, describing their properties, and sorting them on the basis of one or two criteria. We have also been using our knowledge of shapes to recognise, continue and create patterns.

Eagle Class have been very busy this half-term.

In literacy the children have been learning about explanation texts. They have been looking at parts of a flower and body parts of different animals. The children have also planted their own seeds and some of them labelled parts of their plant.



In mathematics the pupils have been learning about temperature, time and capacity. The children have really enjoyed exploring cold ice and warm pancakes.

They also loved filling and emptying cups with sand and water and comparing them to see which had more water in them.
